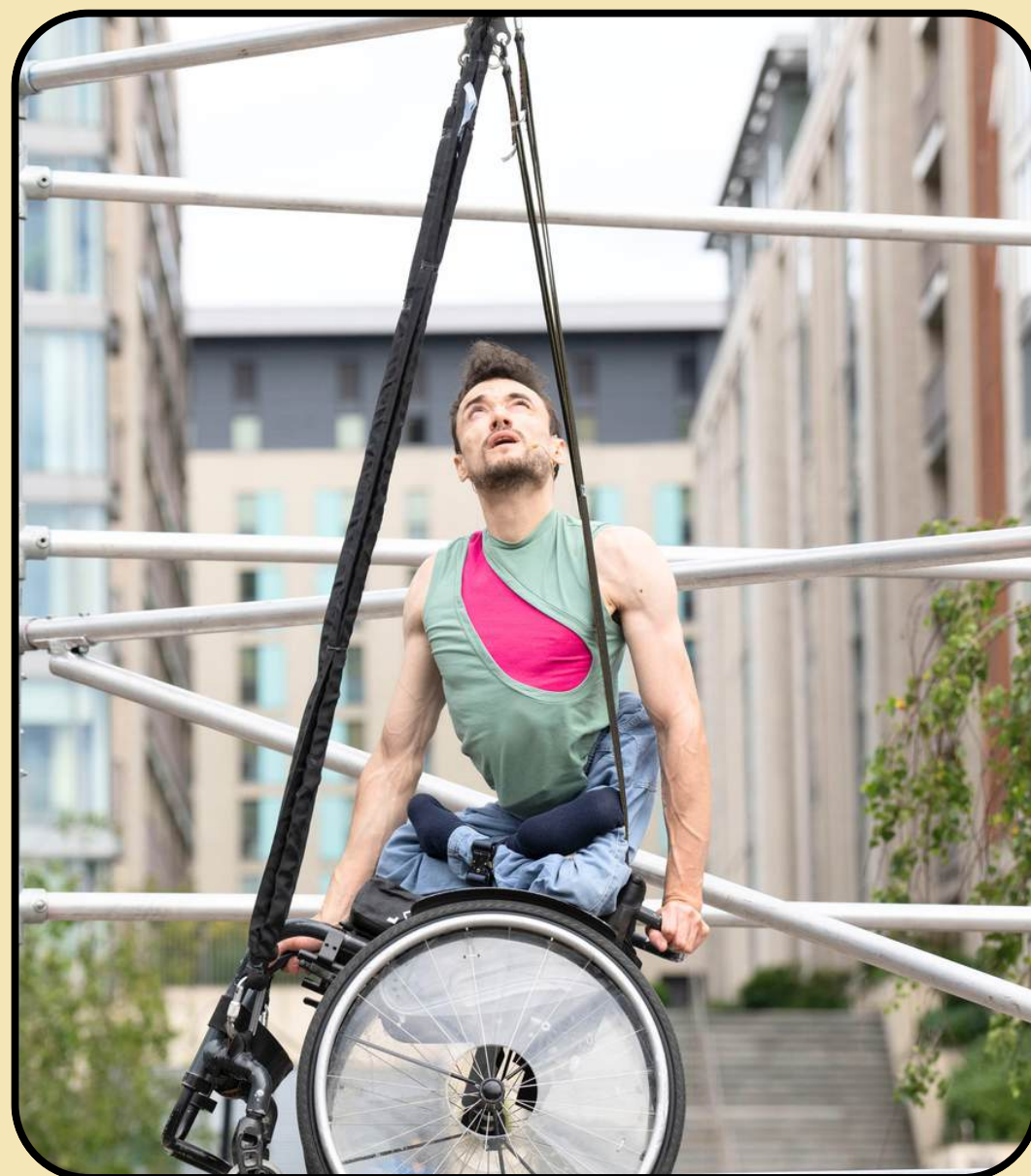

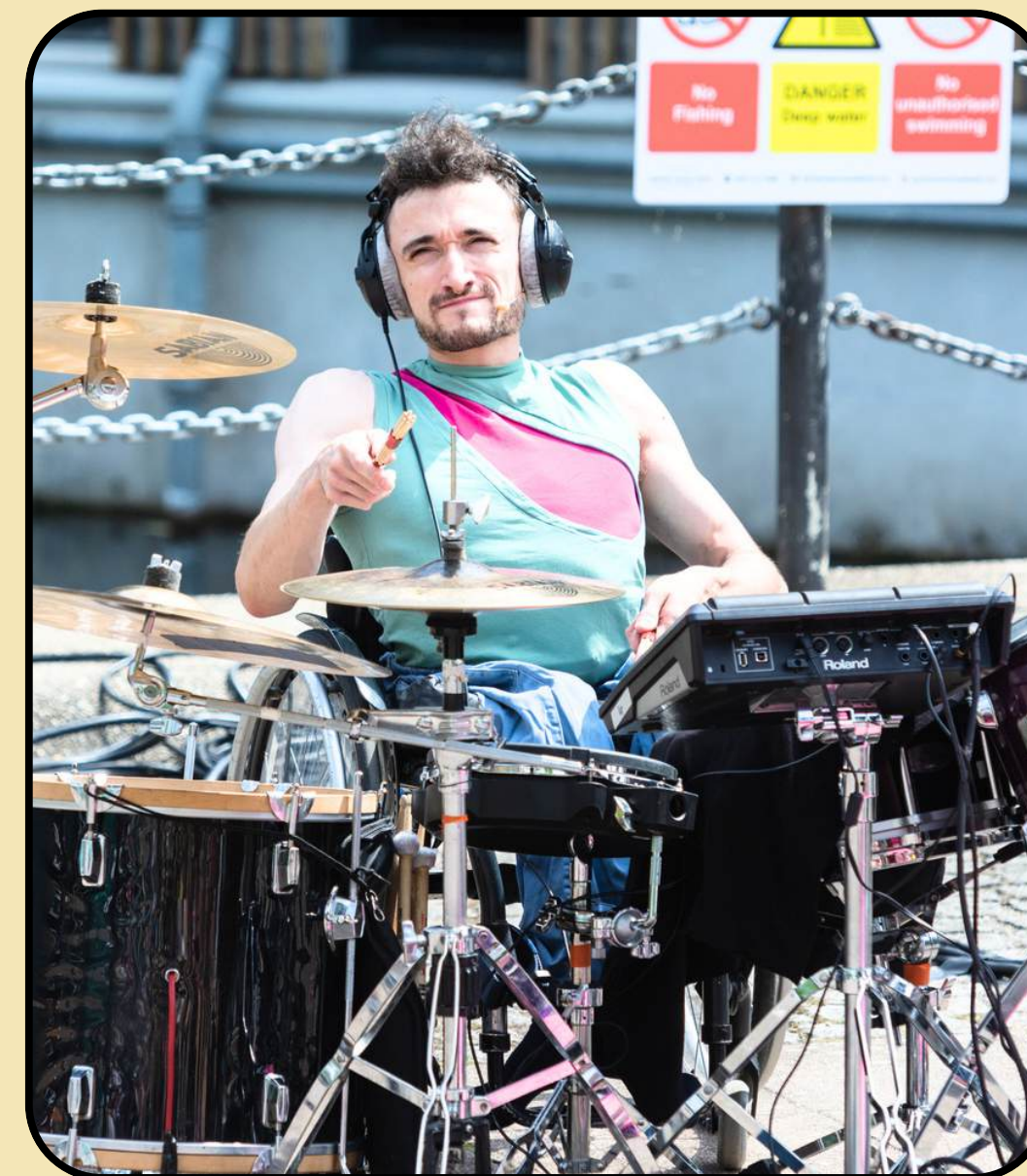

Phoebe is a movement and counterweight performer as well as a musician in the show. Sometimes you will see Phoebe on the double bass.

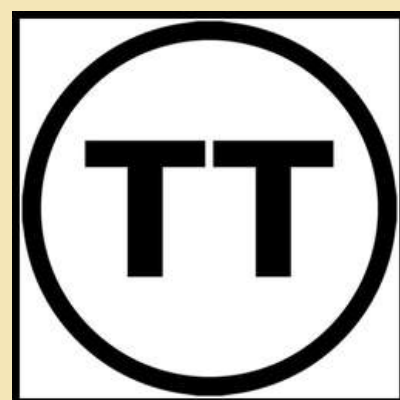


Audience Information

What happens in the show?



Beginning

The show starts with Tilly, Phoebe & Jonny on stage in front of the giant triangular tower.

The performers introduce themselves.

Jonny Climbs the Tower



Jonny climbs to the top of the tower whilst Tilly & Phoebe spin the tower.

Tilly Climbs the Tower



Tilly climbs the tower to discover all of the things she could be whilst she climbs and moves her body around the tower.

Phoebe sets up the tower



Phoebe shows us how you can set up the tower and equipment with creative certainty.

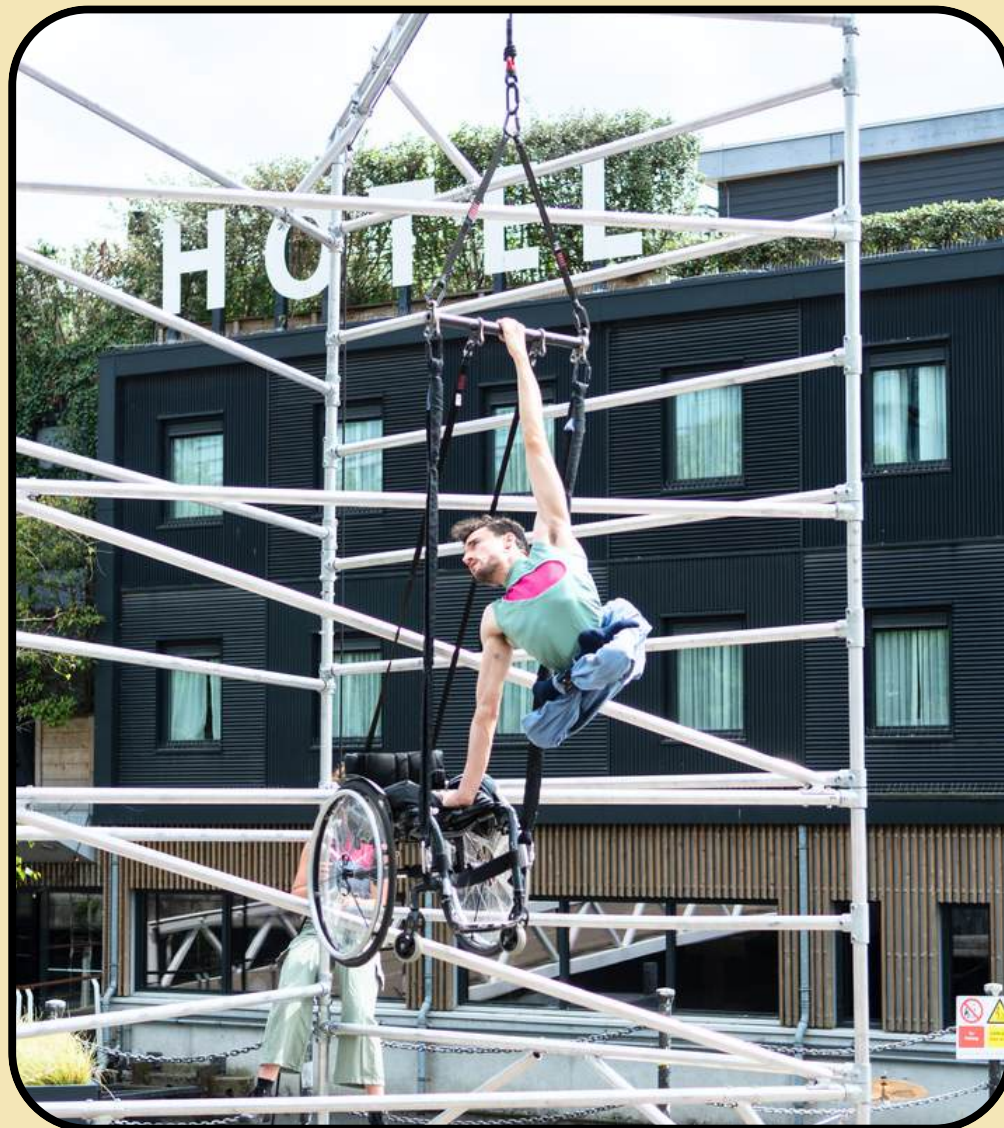
Phoebe & Tilly

Counterweight each other



Phoebe and Tilly take it in turns to hold each others weight. They are attached by a rope which allows them to let go of the tower and float.

Jonny does a duet with his chair



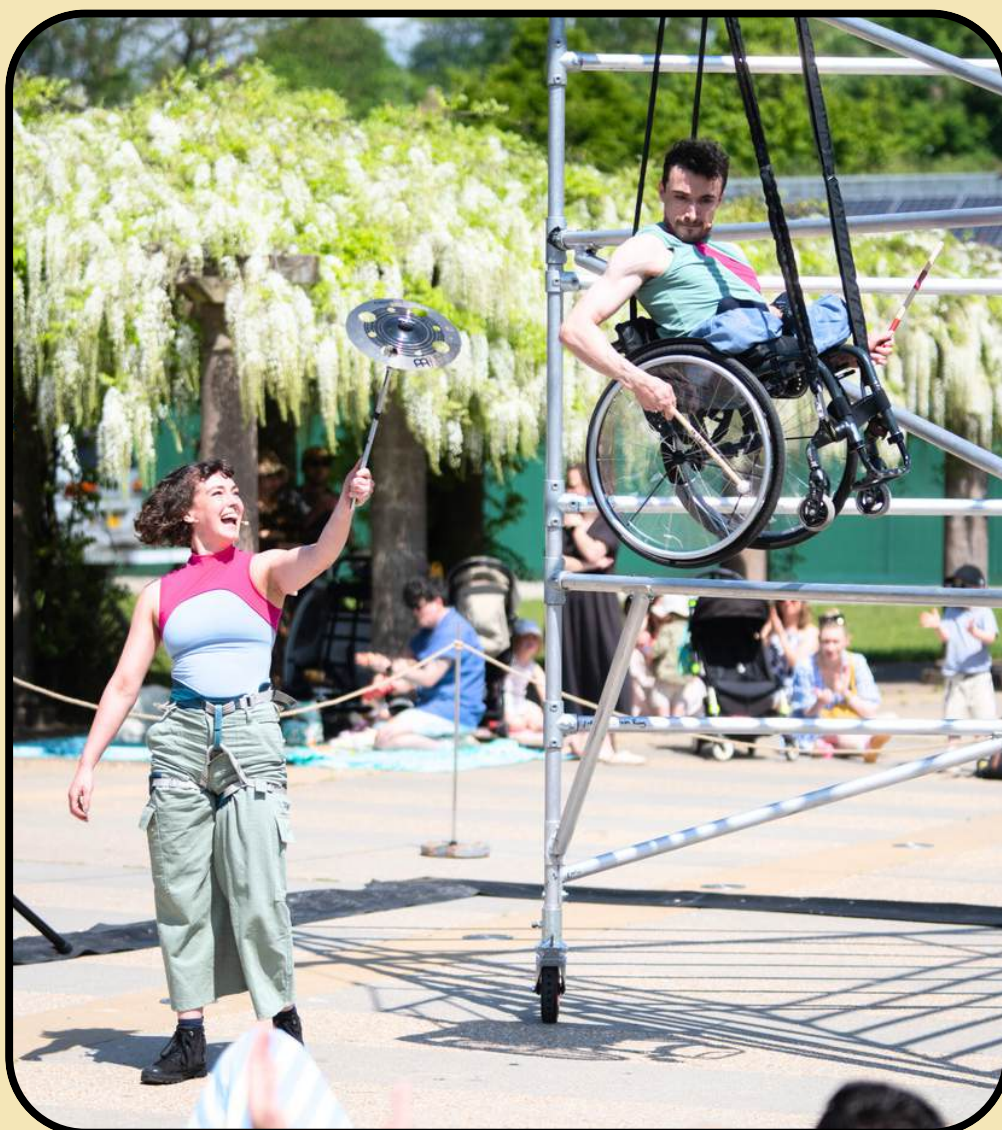
Jonny does a movement duet with his wheelchair whilst in the air.
