DIRECTOR'S NOTE

Everything we do has a natural frequency. All motion has a vibration and sound.

Three years ago a 'ping' on my computer alerted me to a new message. I opened it and discovered it was from Conor Guilfoyle – the jazz percussionist. It was an invitation to experiment – borne from the feeling that as he plays the drums, Conor imagines himself dancing or dance being an extension of how he creates sound from the drum kit.

Coincidently – I had been researching sound – how it moves, how the waves and vibrations have huge influences on how we feel, behave – and how we use these energy pulses as primary ways to communicate.

And so we met, and workshopped some ideas focussing on the science behind the making of rhythm. How the dancers bodies could not only respond to sound — but they could create a unique universe and vibe that affects the rehearsal room and drives the work itself. Together we explored the fundamental frequencies of motion and the profound effects these have on the body.

In creating the piece I have had an extraordinary opportunity to play with visualising sound waves — and together with the dancers to discover how greatly sound vibration can communicate complex ideas. Live music has always played a huge part in CoisCéim's previous creations — by marrying Conor's extensive knowledge of the history of jazz music and percussion with my own body of experience of jazz and commercial dance and its roots — **THE PIECE WITH THE DRUMS** will deepen and add colour to our experience of the symbiotic relationship between dance and music.

I would like to say a special thank you to the dancers who have brought so much to the work, to all of the team who have supported the creation and to Conor for the 'ping'. We hope that you enjoy the performance and sharing the space together.

PERFORMER

Originally from New Zealand, Justine has been based in Ireland as a freelance dance artist, teacher and choreographer since 2008. A guest lecturer at The University of Limerick, Dance Ireland & Dance Theatre of Ireland & recently graduated as an advanced teacher in Quan Yin Qi Gong. As a dance artist Justine has had the pleasure of working most recently with CoisCéim Dance Theatre, Croí Glan, Justine Doswell, Junk Ensemble, Jools Gilson, Liz Roche Company, Laura Murphy, Mary Wycherly, Oona Doherty, United Fall, Maria Nilsson Waller, Anu Productions & Dead Center among many others. As a Movement Director Justine has worked with Ann Cleare on MIDHE (large scale orchestra & choir work at the National Concert Hall), Una Kavanagh, Corn Exchange's MISFITS. (nominated Best Movement Direction 2018 Irish Times Theatre Awards). & Noelle Brown Theatre Company, Justine was a member of Meryl Tankard Australian Dance Theatre from 1998-2000. Her own work Folds of the Crane was presented as part of Tiger Dublin Fringe Festival 2015 (nominated for Spirit of the Fringe & Best Lighting & Design) and was also presented at Dublin Dance Festival 2016 and What's Next Festival 2018.

IVONNE KALTER

PERFORMER

Ivonne studied at Heinz Bosl Stiftung Ballet Academy in Munich and subsequently at Iwanson School of Contemporary Dance. She her professional debut in 2009 stage choreographer Jochen Heckmann's cast at TIK Theatre Kempten. Since then, she has travelled extensively with shows, to teach and to draw inspiration for her work, honing her distinctive style and movement. Ivonne's impactful work has received international acclaim, including the Isadora Award in 2010 for the most promising young dancer. She is an associate artist of Levantes Dance Theatre in London, who combine contemporary circus and dance-theatre. She enjoys working with people of all ages, leading workshops for the community and professional dance education programmes, and is a certified yoga teacher. Her work with CoisCéim includes: Invitation to a Journey, The Wolf and Peter, Body Language, In the Magic Hour, How to Sink a Paper Boat and Francis Footwork.

JONATHAN MITCHELL

PERFORMER

Jonathan graduated from the Rambert School, London, in 1992. Since then he has been fortunate to work with a host of choreographers and companies, including Adventures in Motion Pictures, Mathew Hawkins, Liz Roche Company and IMDT, performing on four continents and in both hemispheres. Jonathan's association with CoisCéim began in 2001 with The Rite of Spring, and he has worked with the company many times since, including When Once Is Never Enough, Mermaids, Pageant, Agnes, The Wolf and Peter, These Rooms, Body Language/In The Magic Hour, Francis Footwork, Orfeo ed Euridice for the Blackwater Valley Opera Festival, Go To Blazes. and Palimpsest.

Donking is a Filipino choreographer, acrobatic teacher, actor and dance fitness coach based in Ireland since 2002. His work with CoisCéim includes Palimpsest, Agnes, Our Fathers and Orfeo ed Euridice for Blackwater Valley Opera Festival. He has danced in RTÉ's Centenary 2016; Irish National Opera's Carmen and RTÉ's Toy Show the Musical. TV and film credits include Harry Wild, The Vikings, Love Hate, Raw, Aisling's Diary, Grand Opening, RTÉ's Ballet Chancers with Monica Loughman and commercials for The Orchard Thieves and EIR Sports. Acting credits include Netflix's NOCEBO with Eva Green, 2023; Love Rosie with Lily Collins, 2015; Herself (Sharon Horgan), 2021; West Side Story (Bord Gais Energy Theatre). Choreography credits include Harry Wild Season 4 with Jane Seymour Masala RTÉ's Tina 2024: Moore Street and **Times** (Dyehouse Films); Cinderella and Matilda Jr (RNR musical society); and assistant choreographer for the annual Gaiety Pantos 2016–2021.

DAVID BOLGER

CHOREOGRAPHER/DIRECTOR

David is the Artistic Director and co-founder of CoisCéim Dance Theatre. His work has been seen by millions of people worldwide and has received prestigious awards for its innovation, performance and choreography. David has directed and choreographed over 30 original productions for CoisCéim, including Dancehall Blues, Palimpsest, Breakin' Brothers, Blazes, Francis Footwork, the highly lauded The Wolf and **Body Language**, and the major international co-production Theatre Award, London International Festival of **Rooms** (Irish Times Theatre (LIFT), TATE Liverpool). His work for the company has been presented at Jacob's Pillow Dance Festival and Peak Performances in the USA, Spring Loaded (The Place) and the Brighton Festival in the UK, Ten Days on the Island (Tasmania), Arts Centre Melbourne and Sydney Opera House (Australia). David has received numerous choreographic commissions for theatre and opera including Druid (Ireland), Spoleto Festival (USA), Guthrie Theatre (USA), RTÉ (Ireland), National Theatre (UK), Abbey Theatre (Ireland) and Opera Ireland. He is a member of Aosdána.

CONOR GUILFOYLE

MUSIC/PERFORMER

Conor is one of Ireland's leading jazz drummers and educators. As a performer he has toured and recorded with some of the finest jazz musicians in the world today. On the domestic front he runs the Conor Guilfoyle Octet and has led many Salsa and Latin jazz groups making the first recordings of that genre in Ireland. He is co-founder of the Newpark music jazz programme now in DCU which offered the first BA in jazz performance in Ireland. He has lectured on many of the leading jazz programs worldwide and is the author of three books, Odd Meter Clave for drum set, Rhythmic reading for drummers and Keeping the drummer occupied.

KATIE DAVENPORT

SET AND COSTUME DESIGN

Katie is a theatre designer, currently in residence at The Dean Art Studio Dublin. She has an Irish Times Theatre Award for costume design 2021 & 2022 and has been nominated twice. Katie has designed for many major theatre, opera and dance companies in Ireland, including The Abbey, The Gate, Irish National Opera, Landmark, United Fall, Liz Roche Company, CoisCéim, Northern Ireland Opera, Theatre Lovett, thisispopbaby and Rough Magic. She recently created the installation **Pegeen's** at The Abbey Theatre — a pop up theatre café. Katie is vice chair of the Irish Society of Stage & Screen Designers and was Designer in Residence at The Gate Theatre Dublin in 2017. She represented Ireland in Beijing NCPA at Evolving Design for Performance in 2016 and again at The Prague Quadrennial 2019, a world exhibition of theatre design.

EAMON FOXLIGHTING DESIGN

Previous lighting designs for CoisCéim include Our Fathers, Missing, Swimming with my Mother and Boxes. Other work includes: Orfeo ed Euridice for Blackwater Valley Opera; The Wasteground Party for The Peacock Theatre (The Abbey); The Visit for Draiocht Arts Centre; Hansel & Gretel, Hans Christian Anderson for Verdant Productions; Chance to Dance film for Jess Rowell Dance & Draiocht; A Holy Show for Verdant Productions; Carmen, The Nutcracker & Swan Lake for Ballet Ireland; The Merchant of Venice, Macbeth, King Lear and Hamlet (nominated for an Irish Times Theatre Award) for Second Age Theatre Company; It Only Ever Happens In The Movies, A Dream Play, The Seagull, A Midsummer's Night Dream and The Caucasian Chalk Circle for The National Youth Theatre at The Peacock Theatre (The Abbey; This is a room, The Comedy of Errors for Dublin Youth Theatre; The Field for Verdant Productions, Stones In His Pockets for Pat Moylan Productions — all at The Gaiety Theatre.

VAL SHERLOCK HAIR & MAKEUP

Val has worked as a hair and makeup artist as well as a wigmaker for a quarter of a century. As well as television, film and advertising work, Val has worked for all major theatre companies in Ireland and Northern Ireland. Val has had the pleasure of working across all aspects of theatre, opera, contemporary dance, and ballet.
